

M-vendor T-trash Any patron of BaconFest that will be drinking an alcoholic beverage will be IDed and must have a single-wear Tyvek bracelet. This is true for patrons getting a beer outside, or those getting a drink from Market alley Wines, Market Alley Tap or Varsity Club.

Alcoholic beverages will be served in plastic cups (or aluminum beer cans- no glass allowed) The tree locations to purchase alcoholic beverages listed on the application (the outdoor beer area, market Ally wines, Market Alley Tap and Varsity Club) Will all have different color plastic cups.

Primary ID and bracelet areas will be by the ticket booth next to the beer stand. There will be "greeters" at the North, East and West Entrances to the square to direct patrons and will have ID bracelets if requested. At each of the four entrances to the square there will be "no alcohol beyond this point" signs.

At the outdoor beer area, NO beer or other alcoholic beverage will be poured to anyone without a bracelet. There will also be an ID and ticket location next to the beer stand in Central Park.

Market Alley Wines, Market Alley Tap and Varsity Club will also have bracelets – anyone who will be carrying out a drink must have it in an approved container and be wearing a bracelet.

We estimate about 40 volunteers during the course o the event will be working in various areas around the square. Ticket sales, Greeters, ID Checkers, garbage pick-up, set up and tear down.

The Monmouth Business Council will provide overtime funding for any extra police officers as recommended by the Police Chief, or his second in command. We have also contacted the auxiliary police for assistance.

The outdoor beer areas will call "last call" at 9:10 and stop serving at 9:20. Market Alley Wines, Market Alley Tap and Varsity Club will also stop pouring for outside customers at 9:20 pm.
