INCIDENTS OF NOTE:

*48 IDOT grant hours were worked resulting in 57 ordinance violations being issued for speeding, distracted driving, seat belt violations and child restraint violations. Several criminal arrests were also made which included 3 warrant arrests and 3 suspended drivers.

*A brief stand off with a knife occurred after a domestic violence incident on July 4. The offending party was taken into custody shortly after. Only a minor injury was reported by the victim of the domestic violence incident.

*July 4th fireworks went smoothly with no major incidents to report. Officers were busy with firework complaint calls that night as they were about a week leading up to July 4th.

*After coming back to work in June, PSO Robbin Avery went back off work due to the existing injury to her wrist having no healed completely.

STAFF TRAINING:

*Several investigators have begun the recertification process as Lead Homicide Investigators. The recertification is an annual mandate through the State of Illinois and requires investigators to take 40 hours of homicide investigative training. The training will culminate with a conference in October.
