Replacement of Lead Service Lines**

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Mayor Rod Davies declared the Public Hearing for the Replacement of Lead Service Lines open at 5:45 p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall, 100 East Broadway.

Zach Malach from Woodard and Curran explained that this Public Hearing is part of the requirement for receiving an IEPA loan, which the City is applying for to assist in bringing them into compliance with the Lead Service Replacement Act. The loan covers a 5-year period with the City replacing an estimated 135 service lines per year, which would total 675 at the end of the 5 years. The total cost of the project is \$5.35 million.

Public Works Director Jackson said that a complete inventory of the number of lead service lines in Monmouth has not been completed, but it is estimated that in the older part of town particularly there is a large number of lead service lines. He also added that all current and future projects would include replacement of any lead service lines if they were encountered.

With no further comments or questions, Mayor Davies closed the Public Hearing at 6:50 p.m.
