INCIDENTS OF NOTE:

- *Active shooter training was conducted at Smithfield for about 100 employees
- *Officers and staff put on Cops and Kids where 25 kids were able to spend \$100 each to buy themselves Christmas gifts. About half of the kids used some of that money to buy Christmas gifts for other family members as well. This is a good time for kids and their parents to interact with police officers in a positive way. *Officers and staff in coordination with Strom Center did Power For Seniors. Gift cards were given away to help pay for power bills. These gift cards were provided by Ameren. Gift cards were given away to help purchase groceries. These gift cardss were provided by Save-a-Lot Foods. There were also hams and turkeys given away to the seniors that were donated by Save-a-Lot Foods.
- *Officers also assisted in giving away 30 hams which were provided by Smithfield, to community members who may have been in need for the holiday season.
- *New patrol rifles were purchased and put into the patrol cars. These rifles were purchased using Special Equipment funds and had no impact on the budget. The rifles are compact in size and will make the deployment of the rifle from the patrol car easier and safer. They are also ideal for close quarter room and building clearing. The new rifles replaced older rifles that were approximately 15 years old.
