The Trust Act generally prohibits local law enforcement in Illinois from participating in federal immigration enforcement and the Voices Act provides procedural protections for immigrants victimized by violent crime who have assisted law enforcement in investigating certain types of crimes and who are seeking a U to T Vista certification
