### INCIDENTS OF NOTE:

\*Chief Switzer attended an area Chief's meeting at the Galesburg Police Department that was organized by the Illinois State Police. The topic of the meeting was the ISP reorganization and how this was going to affect the area agencies.

\*MPD began the on-boarding process of a scheduling and payroll system called PACE Scheduler. The new system will digitize the scheduling process for MPD officers, dispatchers and administrative staff. The new system will also track payroll and employee time banks allowing MPD to move away from Excel spreadsheets.

\*MPD administrative officers took part in a body worn camera demonstration from Axon. MPD is required by State law to have body worn cameras by July 1, 2025. The goal is to have all MPD officers wearing body worn cameras prior to that date. MPD has applied for grant funding through the Illinois Training and Standards Board and the federal government for the implementation of a body worn camera program.

### STAFF TRAINING:

\*Police Executive Coordinator Julie Richardson attended a Freedom of Information Act webinar. Julie is the FOIA officer for the department.

### EQUIPMENT RELATED ISSUES:

\*Several squad cars were repaired during the month correcting brake issues and Ford recall issues. Both of the squad cars are high mileage cars but they are still serviceable continue to be in the fleet rotation.
