INCIDENTS OF NOTE:

- *MPD provided active shooter training to the Henderson Co. Sheriff's Dept.
- *MPD received CPR training equipment and will begin CPR training for officers, dispatchers in the near future. We are also reaching out to the school districts to provide CPR training to teachers and staff
- *MPD along with the West Central Drug Task Force opened 3 separate methamphetamine cases in Monmouth
- *During the month of June and first part of July, MPD conducted grant funded patrols focusing on seat belt usage and cell phone usage. A total of 18 seat belt violations were cited and 10 cell phone usage violations were cited.
- *Ofc. Marlon Williams represented MPD at the American Cancer Society's Cancer Walk
- *Chief Switzer talked on the radio about fireworks, and distracted driving

STAFF TRAINING:

- *Officer attended Critical Incident Mental Health Training. This training involves going over changes to procedures involving mental health response and collaboration with mental health providers for the officers
- *An officer attended a Rescue Task Force training event. This course is designed to train police officers in the specialized skill sets necessary to perform alongside other emergency services in an active threat rescue environment

EQUIPMENT RELATED ISSUES:

- *One squad car was identified for a recall for a mechanical issue. It was taken to Yemm Ford and repaired
