## INCIDENTS OF NOTE:

\*MPD has taken part in several large drug investigations that involve our community. No other information can be reported at this time due to the investigation continuing. We continue working hard at interdicting drugs that are coming into our community.

\*Chief Switzer met with AFSCME representatives from the Dispatch Center on issues moving forward from the effects COVID has had on the Dispatchers and the operation of the Dispatch Center.

\*Chief Switzer attended the Monmouth/Warren County Auxiliary meeting. COVID has affected their role also in helping the community and they were seeking guidance on moving forward.

\*As you can see by the number of arrests and grant hours worked, MPD has again started doing targeted traffic enforcement details. The details are State and Federally funded targeting distracted driving, seat belt compliance and driving under the influence.

\*Update on staffing: We currently still have two officers off due to extended illness and one officer off due to an on-duty injury. We continue to train dispatchers to fill full time vacancies we have in the dispatch center.
