INCIDENTS OF NOTE:

*MPD is in the process of transitioning to computer software for creating the police and dispatch schedules. Up to this point the scheduling for officers and dispatchers has been done with pen and paper, then transferred to Excel and is time consuming. The goal of the scheduling software is to reduce the time needed to address schedules and the many changes that occur weekly. The software also includes text messaging/email sending and receiving for day off requests and their review. The software is inexpensive and should make daily addressing of the schedules easier and less time consuming.

*C and D Electric has now started replacing all the fluorescent lights inside the building with LED lights. A grant from Ameren is providing the funding for the new lights.

*The FOP held their Cops and Bobbers fishing derby which saw approximately 200 kids at Citizens Lake for a fun time fishing and getting prizes.

*A full-time dispatcher, Alexis Johnson finished training and is now on her own filling a vacancy on the dispatch schedule. There are still two dispatchers in training currently.

*We were notified that Ofc. Beckman will be returning to duty from his extended leave of absence at the end of this month.

STAFF TRAINING:

*MPD officers completed approximately 150 hour of training that are mandated by ILETSB. The training covers various topics to include Civil Rights, Use of Force, Cultural Competency, Procedural Justice, Law Updates and Constitutional Use of Law Enforcement Authority.

EQUIPMENT RELATED ISSUES:

*Two squad cars that were damaged in February and March in accidents were repaired. Accidents were caused by other parties.

*Several desk chairs throughout the building have been replaced, old ones were either broken or wore out. There are still several that need replaced in the near future.
