INCIDENTS OF NOTE:

- *Two MPD officers tested positive for COVID19, they have since recovered and returned to duty.
- *One dispatcher is quarantined due to a household member possibly having COVID19, test results have not come back at this time.
- *Ballistic plates that were donated to MPD have been deployed in several of the squad cars. These plates with the carrier can be utilized by an officer as additional protection in addition to what the officers currently wear.
- *MPD received notification that the Department is in compliance with the federal use of force guidelines. This is a mandatory certification that jurisdictions must achieve if they do or plan on receiving federal funding. The accrediting agency is the Illinois Chiefs of Police Association and consists of submitting MPD policies and protocols on the use of force to the Illinois Chiefs of Police Association to verify they meet federal standards. Prior to the order and certification going into effect this year, MPD policies and protocols already met the federal standards.
- *MELC held their annual Turkey Trot without incident.
- *Christmas on The Square was held without incident.
- *An active shooter drill was conducted at MRJH and MRHS.
- *MPD continues to sanitize the building and squad cars. Reminders are sent frequently to all members of the department to sanitize individual work spaces, wash hands, wear masks, use hand sanitizer and to social distance.
- *MPD did install three air sanitizers, one in the dispatch center and two in the common areas of the building. These air sanitizers use UV light and ozone to sanitize the air killing virus particles that may be airborne.
