1. That the proposed improvement shall consist of

For the Mill and Overlay of N 6th St. (E Broadway Ave. to E Euclid Ave.) with the following work efforts: Seeding, Class 1A, Erosion Control Blanket, Bituminous Surface Removal (Milling), Special 2", Bituminous Material (Tack Coat SS-1), HMA Binder Course, IL-9.5, N50, 2.5", HMA Surface Course, IL-9.5, Mix "D", N50, 1.5", PCC Driveway Pavement, 7 Inch, PCC Driveway Pavement (Special), 7 Inch, PCC Sidewalk 4", Detectable Warnings, Combination Curb and Gutter Removal, Driveway Pavement Removal, Sidewalk Removal, Agggregate Surface Course, Type B, Water Valves to Be Adjusted, Inlet Removal, Inlets, Type A, Type 3 Frame and Grate, Storm Sewer Connection, Manholes to be Adjusted, Combination Curb and Gutter, Type B-6.18, Butt Joint, Removing and Resetting Street Signs, and Traffic Control Complete. The City intends to use all of their Rebuild Funds towards construction work and to supplement construction and construction inspection engineering fees with Local Funds

2. That there is hereby appropriated the sum of Six Hundred Twenty-Two Thousand Three Hundred Ninety-Six and 74/100 Dollars (\$622,396.74) for the improvement of said section from the Local Public Agency's allotment of Motor Fuel Tax funds.
