Monmouth Rotary is requesting assistance from the City in the construction of a new fountain in Central Park. This project is project part of our centennial celebration set for September 2018.

Attached is an estimate for the project that is broken down between demolition and infrastructure and new construction. Monmouth Rotary is specifically asking the City to participate in the demolition and infrastructure portion of the project. We understand that his may include the replacement of existing water mains located beneath the current fountain.

The cost estimates are preliminary and we would assume that the City could complete some of this work internally. This could bring down the estimated costs significantly.

Also, attached are architectural concepts of what the proposed new fountain will look like. As illustrated, the main feature of the new fountain will be multiple water jets that will be easier to maintain than the current fountain. In addition, we anticipate the new fountain will also have a colored light feature which will be displayed at night.

We look forward to presenting our plans at the Council meeting on December 5th and will be prepared to answer whatever questions there may be.
