

## Annual Increases In Police & Fire Pension Contributions 2009 – 2020




Fire Pension Police Pension

Local taxes have contributed a total of \$13,772,550 to the Police and Fire pension over the last 12 years.

Even with these significant increases in contributions, the City's unfunded liability has grown during this same time period. In the past 10 years, City contributions to Police and Fire pensions have increased **128%** 


## Growth In Assessed Valuation 2013 – 2020


## Changes In Property Tax Rate: 2011 – 2020 City Of Monmouth, Illinois

## City Property Tax Revenue Allocation 2020 Tax Levy - \$2,416,500



69.0% of the City's Property Tax Levy is used to make mandatory contributions to the Police and Fire pension funds.
